Admission

- 1. Every child for admission must be introduced personally by the parent or one who will be responsible to the principal for his/ her conduct and fee.
- 2. The admission form must be filled with the almost possible accuracy.
- 3. A candidate who has attended a recognized school cannot be admitted without a transfer certificate from the school last attended. The others must produce an authentic birth certificate.
- 4. Children are admitted purely on test basis form the age of 3 years on wards.
- 5. Before removing a student from the school of months' notice is to or a month's fee in lieu of notice.
- 6. No transfer certificate will be issued until all dues to the school have been paid in full. The transfer certificate only be given receipt of a written application from the parent or guardian.

N.B. :- School fees are subject to be charged any time as per the establishment and maintenance cost.

General Information

- Both boys and girls are taught in this institution.
- The classes are held from Nursery to Stander X (10th).
- ➤ Holidays: Every Saturday is a half working day. School will be closed on Sunday and second Saturdays. Other important public holidays will also holidays for the school.
- > The academic year its from April to March. On class days except half days and at school functions pupil must wear the prescribed uniform. Boys and Girls must come to school neat and tidy.
- Irregular attendance unjustified or unexplained absence. Habitual late coming, disobedience or objectionable behavior of any kind may result in removal of the student from the school.
- Any child bears outstanding dues for the session will neither be allowed to appear in the examination not be considered for promotion to the next class.
- On being absent a leave application from infectious diseases or exposed to such disease in their homes must complete the guarantee period before rejoining school. This should be indicated on the basis of medical certificate.

Note: The school is not responsible for the loss of books stationary or any other valuable things of the student during the school hours or ways to school or home.



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Examinations

- 1. There are six examinations in our school according to the CBSE curriculum. They are four formative assessment (FA1, FA2, FA3, FA4) and two Summative assessment (SA1 and SA2).
- 2. Prescribed syllabus will be given starting of every school year.
- 3. Examination dates will be announced on 20 days before every exams.
- 4. Re-examination will not be conducted at any ground. So it is compulsory to attend examination of all subjects.
- 5. Failed students will be have attend in a compart examination after announcing the final result.
- 6. The school will not responsible for student entry refusal in the examination hall due to non-payment.

Note: All students can be obtained some marks through the internal assessment.
